Revenues: \$614k under budget YTD for the month of November, Revenues are tracking behind budget, but are \$54k higher than last year.

- Interest \$1,300 over budget Tracking higher than budget, but on track with the prior year
- Memberships \$647k under budget Tracking under the previous year. This is fluid and has to do
 with the Early Bird TMAs, as the season hasn't opened up yet. Once the final numbers are gone
 through for the Early Bird, we should have an idea on the full impact.
- Marketing & Contract \$72k over budget Tracking over previous year as well by \$48k, tied to the

offsetting expenses for the Green Mountain National Forest.

- · Sale Items/Media & Communication Tracking on budget and with prior year
- Contracted Serviced & Misc. \$40k under budget Tracking in line with prior year Includes trail signs and other miscellaneous income.

Expenses: \$398k under budget YTD - For the month of November, expenses are tracking behind budget,

but are \$138k higher than last year, mostly due to the GMNF expenses. The largest under

budget variances were attributed to Operating & Business expenses and the Trail Gen Expenses - Related to the GMNF expenses. All other expenses are tracking close to budget and the prior fiscal year.
